It is a broad insurance plan that besides covering basic needs, also covers possible medical expenses after an accident and a daily allowance in case of hospitalization and immobilization.</p> <p>Those who fall into the student category are automatically covered by insurance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for all activities carried out in the university facilities • for transfer between different university facilities • for participating in sports activities organized by the University of Pisa or operated by the CUS (University Sports Center), with the exclusion of certain types (boxing, weightlifting, wrestling in its various forms, hiking with rock or ice climbing, caving, ski jumping, waterski, acrobatic skiing, bobsled, rugby, skydiving, paragliding and air sports in general)
