





Call for Erasmus+ KA107 Student Mobility for Study2022/2023

at the Universidad de León (Spain)

Within the framework of the Erasmus+ program (Key Action 107) the Universidad de León has been the beneficiary of a grant destined to finance mobility stays during the 2022/2023 academic year. Under the 2020-1-ES01-KA107-080449 project and in partnership with the University of Kairouan (Tunisia), the Vice Rectorate for Internationalisation of the Universidad de León offers 3 grants for students from University of Kairouan to study at the Universidad de León.

Requirements

- Applicants must be students of Master or licence in Computer science or Computer science doctorate students at University of Kairouan
- · Applicants must be at least in their second year of higher education studies in a Computer science speciality
- High motivation and excellent academic performance are required.
- Students that have been beneficiaries of an Erasmus+ grant previously, must not exceed the 12 month scholarship period limit for undergraduate studies.
- · Knowledge of Spanish / English at level B1 is essential.
- Mobility must be completed before end of July 2023.
- Beneficiaries will need to take an accident and emergency insurance that covers the duration of their mobility, we require the Oncampus insurance for their extensive coverage.

- Every mobility should have the possibility of academic recognition.

Financial support

Each grant will be financed as follows:

- Individual support: 850€ per month (up to a maximum of 5 months)
- Travel expenses: 275€.

Time

The period of stay comprises a minimum of 3 months and up to a maximum of 5 months.

Applications

The applicants will be invited to submit their candidatures to the selection committee, which will be held in the university according to deadline agenda. The candidates must send the required documents to the following email address: icmunivk@gmail.com

A first administrative selection will be done to verify the completeness of the demanded recordings. All incompleteness and any leak of document will exclude the candidature. After the first selection, the committee will apply a second and last selection based on a set of selection criteria and a valorization scale. In corresponding date, the result of selection will be published online on the university portal and the successful candidates will be invited by email to complete with the process. Any delay will exclude the candidature and open the opportunity to the following candidate just in the following range regarding the ranking list. There will be two rankings, one for the license students and one for Master students. The committee will accord one grant for the first category and two grants for the second category. There will be two waiting lists associated to the two categories which are used in case of delays or uncompleted process of candidature.









The application documents:

- A- A motivation letter
- B- A curriculum vitae (Europass format)
- C- A copy of the first page of the passport (valid passport)
- D- English translation of all transcripts for higher education years of study
- E- English translation of all higher education diploma
- F- A certified copies of the all finished international traineeships
- G- A proof of B1 level in English language

Valorisation scale and selection criteria

The commission will assess the submitted applications guaranteeing, at all times, the principles of equality, merit, capacity and publicity. The assessment criteria to be taken into consideration when assessing submitted applications are as follows:

The scores are calculated /20 by (Criteria 1+ Criteria 2)/2 as follows:

- Criteria 1: The excellence of university transcripts associated to the last diploma which is calculated according to the average value of grading notations for all presented transcripts. A maximum of 20 points (4 points if grading notation is equivalent to Satisfactory, 6 points if grading notation is equivalent to Good, 8 points if grading notation is equivalent to Very good, 10 points if grading notation is equivalent to Excellent) will be considered
- Criteria 2: English language skills. Maximum of 20 points

Remark: the grading scale given in the grading systems of HEI adopted in the convention is considered as reference
